## **Outlook and Authenticator Apps for your**



## **Android Mobile Device**

<u>Disclaimer</u>: Due to variations in Android devices, all Android devices may not follow the exact steps below. This tip sheet reflects the most common solution.

Download the Outlook App and Microsoft Authenticator App

- 1. Get and install both the Outlook App and the Microsoft Authenticator App on your Android mobile device from the Google Play Store. (There are several Authenticator Apps verify it's the MICROSOFT AUTHETICATOR app). You must have the Authenticator app in order to use the Outlook app.
- 2. Open the Outlook app once both apps have finished downloading.



**3.** Type in your UMMC email address and tap "Continue".



**4.** Type in your network password. Tap "Sign in".



5. Tap "Register".




**6.** Tap "Activate" then "Go To Store". Install & open Intune Company

Portal app\*.





7. Tap "OK". Then tap "Sign in".



**8.** Create a 6-digit pin. Then re-enter that pin to confirm it. Tap "Send". Then tap "Activate" on the next screen.




**9.** Tap "Activate" to continue.




**10.** Tap "**OK**". This can be turned off under the Settings menu in the app after setup if desired.



**11.** If needed, tap "Update" to continue. Then "Update" again in Google Play.



**12.** Open *Authenticator* to verify your Azure AD\*\* account has been added.



**13.** Open *Outlook* to use mobile email & calendar.

Use the button in the top-left corner next to "Inbox" to navigate between folders and access the Settings



Use the menu at the bottom to navigate between Mail, Search and Calendar.

**Note:** It will take a couple of minutes for your calendar to sync. You may have to close and reopen the Outlook app to verify your calendar has synced after a couple of minutes.

- \*Intune must remain on your Android device for Outlook & Authenticator to work. No other action on your part is needed.
- \*\*Azure AD is simply the account name given by Microsoft Authenticator which is tied to your UMMC credentials.
