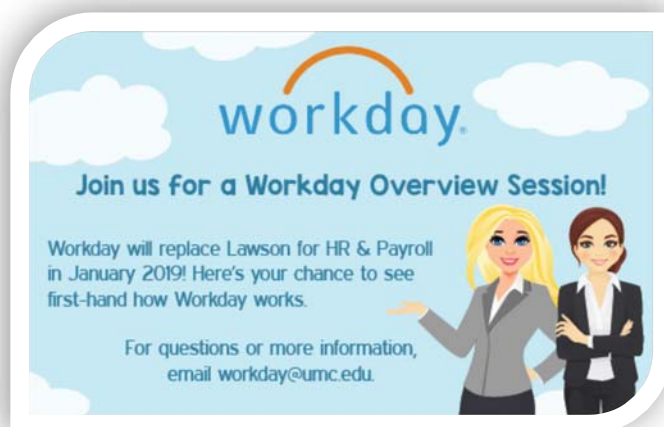

We have groups testing our HCM system processes from end-to-end, and groups in Finance and Supply Chain/Procurement gearing up to begin their first rounds of testing. We are continuing to test on Payroll and have been very pleased by the results.

It's an exciting time for our end-users, too, because the Workday Overview Sessions will begin this week. These sessions will provide the next opportunity for everyone to get a glimpse of the Workday system (what we've built for HCM) in action. Our trainers are refining the job aids and other training materials that we will roll out to the campus in a month or so – be sure to keep an eye out for that!

## Where are we in the project?

The HCM and payroll teams have begun End-to-End (E2E) testing. This testing includes the core HR team plus additional HR team members, which will provide additional exposure to the process and functionality configured for UMMC. Our SCI (project consultants) and UMMC resources will address issues that are discovered in E2E testing promptly. Change orders derived from issues found during E2E will go through approval process and, if approved, will be tested again during E2E or will be postponed to the next test cycle in the configuration process, which is User Acceptance Testing (UAT), occurring at the end of October.

The Financials team is identifying and prioritizing reporting needs. Financials and Supply Chain Management continue to participate in design sessions. This month, they began drafting unit test scenarios in preparation for unit testing on October 22, 2018.

Cross-team collaboration is taking place between HCM and FIN in regards to job classifications/profiles and Foundation Data Models.

## FAQs

### *What is an application and what happened to worklets?*

The Workday landing (home) page displays icons they have defined as applications. Prior to version 31 (Workday's current version), the icons on the landing page were defined as worklets.

### *When will I get training?*

Training will take place beginning November 2018 and will continue through the Workday go-live. We will provide training in multiple formats including job aids, face-to-face instructor-led, live online, hands on, eLearnings, videos, and open lab sessions.
