
## Where are we in the project?

The HCM and Payroll Unit testing is complete. The team will begin Customer Confirmation Sessions next week. These sessions are designed to allow for a walkthrough of the system configurations of business processes that have been built. These are cross functional and intended for the project team. End to End testing will be conducted for the HCM work streams starting the middle of September through October. To better align with the needs of the organization, SCI team is fine-tuning the processes and workflows that were identified and entered as change requests during unit testing.

The Financials team has identified their unit testing team. Unit testing will occur in late Fall for the financials team. The graphic to the right will provide you with a holistic view of the Financials/Supply Chain Project Target Milestones and Progress at this point. The Integrations Team will begin the Code-A-Thon next week with our implementation partners. This intensive, focused week is when the team will build and finalize the vital integrations of systems like Kronos with Workday.

The Workday landing page displays icons they have defined as worklets. These worklets give you access to tasks that can be performed, data that can be viewed, and links for additional resources.

### Will everyone have the same homepage view in Workday?

With Workday, you have the ability to customize your worklets and move them around in the order you want them. The data behind the worklets is populated based on who you are in the organization and your security in the system, but you will have the ability to change the look and feel of the landing page (homepage) to what works for you in your daily work life and processes.
