Where are we in the project?

HCM and Payroll Unit Testing started on 7-16-18 to evaluate if individual business processes determined in the design phase are working properly and triggering the right steps and approvals through the processes.

The experience gained from the unit testing process will help us prepare for the End-to-End (E2E) testing, which will require a larger group of cross functional Subject Matter Experts (SMEs) to follow the HCM and payroll processes in Workday from start to finish.

The Financials team is very busy with high leveling design sessions and functional lead training is occurring.

The Integrations Team continues to work on creating EIBs for the HCM phase of the Workday implementation. We have scheduled a Code-a-Thon in August with our implementation partners, SCI.

The Student team continues to work on the inventory of current reports. We have begun defining the training needs for our core users, functional leads, analysts, and developers.
