5: Outstanding. The student displays an excellent grasp of the material and understands not only the underlying concepts, but also how to apply them.

4: Very Good. The student understands the fundamental concepts of the given discipline, and can apply them to solving real-world problems with some assistance from the faculty.

3: Good. The student has a general knowledge of the key concepts of the discipline and can work through application of them to a given problem with help from the faculty.

2: Poor. The student has an incomplete grasp of the fundamental concepts of the discipline, and even with help from the faculty cannot recall key facts.

1: Failure. The student lacks knowledge of key facts and concepts in the discipline.

Passing: An overall score of greater than or equal to 3.00 and a score of 1 or 2 in no more than one discipline.
