



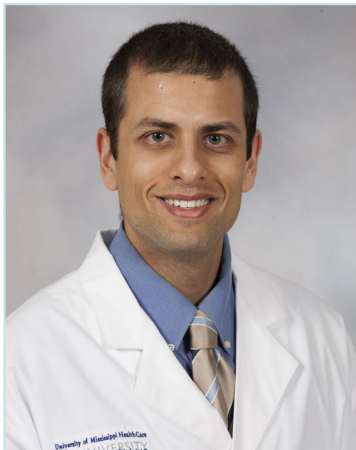

### Objectives:

- A. Understand the importance of screening for critical congenital heart disease
- B. Understand some limitations of pulse oximetry as a screening tool
- C. Gain knowledge about identifying areas of improvement when implementing a CHD screening program

Dr. Sarosh P. Batlivala, MD will be our speaker for latest Population Health Grand Rounds. Dr. Batlivala joined the University of Mississippi Medical Center (UMMC) in 2013. He helped create a Pediatric Cardiology Fellowship and serves as the Program Director in addition to serving as the Director of all Pediatric Fellowship Training Programs. Dr. Batlivala completed a Master of Science in Clinical Investigation in December 2017 with his MSCI thesis work focused on newborn screening programs for critical congenital heart disease.
