Objectives:

1. Enhance knowledge of key components of writing a grant submission with an increased chance for funding
2. Measure knowledge of key information needed in each required section of a NIH grant
3. Increase knowledge of what grant reviewers respond to positively in a grant submission

Dr. Michael Stefanek joined UMMC in July 2019 as Associate Director of the Cancer Control, Epidemiology and Disparities Research (CCEDR) program, Cancer Center and Research Institute (CCRI), University of Mississippi Medical Center. His primary appointment is Professor, Psychiatry and Human Behavior (Division of Psychology), with a secondary appointment as Professor, School of Population Health (Department of Population Health Sciences).

Dr. Stefanek started his career on faculty with the Sidney Kimmel Comprehensive Cancer Center (Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine) He has also held leadership positions as Branch Chief with the National Institutes of Health (Division of Cancer Control and Population Science, National Cancer Institute), Vice President, Behavioral Research and Director of the Behavioral Research Center with the American Cancer Society, and Associate Vice President for Research, Indiana University. He has also chaired the Department of Psychological Sciences at Augusta University. He has published over 100 articles in the area of cancer control, co-authored 16 book chapters and 1 book. He has served as reviewer for over 25 different professional journals. Dr. Stefanek has been funded with NIH K08, R03, R01 and P01 level grants. He has also received funding from the American Cancer Society, the Association for Psychological Sciences, and has received a number of institutional research awards. He has served as a study section reviewer for the NIH, ACS and the Patient Centered Outcomes Research Institute (PCORI), along with both local and international research review panels. During his almost decade long stay with NIH, Dr. Stefanek attended dozens of NIH study section review panels and has presented on grant writing on various occasions, including presentations to the Indiana University School of Medicine and several professional societies. Finally, Dr. Stefanek has served as Chair of the American Association for Cancer Research (AACR) Task force on Behavioral Science and is a Fellow, Society of Behavioral Medicine
