RLDatix created a propriety taxonomy that meets the requirements for the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality (AHRQ). Project Details

1. Describe the commodity/service that the agency/institution is seeking to procure: RLDatix is a patient safety organization that produces web-based incident reporting and risk management software. UMMC uses RLDatix for the Office of Patient Experience data, incident reporting and clinical risk management.

2. Explain why the commodity/service is the only one (1) that can meet the needs of the agency/institution:

This software is highly customizable and UMMC has leveraged the software to develop user and role specific work-flows and reporting. The RLDatix system can be configured to meet the specific needs of the customer. Flexibility in form design, workflow and overall access to the system allows for the uniquely configured system built to the requirements of the customer. The system allows for the linking of modules to give an organization detailed information about the events, complaints, etc. that are being tracked within the system. This functionality also allows for the identification of patients, employees or visitors that are linked to multiple events within the system.

3. Explain why the source is the only person or entity that can provide the required commodity/service:

RLDatix builds software that reduces the impact of harm and helps organizations continually learn and improve.

4. Explain why the amount to be expended for the commodity/service is reasonable:

The estimated amount to be expended for the purchase of the Incident Reporting System software is \$163,625.81. Please be advised that UMMC will determine if additional enhancements, upgrades, support, or equipment are within scope during the certification period and may increase the spending authority accordingly. Should RLDatix change their name during this certification period, then UMMC will determine if a recertification is necessary. This amount is within the expected price range for this software.

5. Describe the efforts that the agency/institution went through to obtain the best possible price for the commodity/service:

Through market intelligence, UMMC was able to negotiate best pricing for these products. All applicable discounts were explored and applied.
