Why doesn't AirCare offer a membership program?

AirCare from University of Mississippi Medical Center™ is the state's most advanced medical helicopter service. We bring critical care to the scene and transport adult, pediatric and neonatal patients to hospitals including UMMC in Jackson, the state's only Level 1 trauma center.

Our helicopters arrive with specialized medical equipment and highly trained Critical Care teams, offering an unmatched level of care. But we don't offer a membership program. Why?

We believe no patient should need a membership to receive affordable air medical transport.

AirCare takes a different approach from membership-driven companies.

- **Cost.** UMMC AirCare rates are significantly less than some for-profit medical helicopter companies in Mississippi, and all AirCare patients are supported by UMMC financial assistance policies
- **Coverage.** Medicare and Medicaid benefits cover air medical transport charges, so patients covered by those programs don't need a membership.
- **Collection.** Patients and families shouldn't suffer financial hardship after a catastrophic injury or illness, so we work directly with families using fair and honorable payment practices.
