TITLE: Off- campus courses and tuition payment Policy

PURPOSE: This policy is to establish guidelines for enrollment of a course at another institution.

POLICY: Although graduate courses necessary to meet the requirements to graduate are available in the SGSHS curriculum, there may be circumstances where a program requires a graduate student to enroll in a course at another institution. If a student's graduate advisory committee requires a graduate student to enroll in a course at another institution, then it is the responsibility of the mentor/graduate program to pay tuition and fees associated with that course. These courses must not constitute more than 30% of the course plan. The graduate student must complete an Office-campus Course Form and obtain approval from the Program Director and Dean of the Graduate School before including such a course in the degree plan. When searching for an institution that offers the necessary course, the following types of institutions should be considered in decreasing order of preference: UMMC campus, Ole Miss campus, other Mississippi colleges and universities, and colleges and universities outside of Mississippi.

If a student enrolls at another institution in a course that is not required by his/her graduate advisory committee, then it is the responsibility of the student to pay tuition and fees associated with that course. This policy applies to students performing non-sponsored as well as sponsored activities whether those students are employees of the university or not.
