General Poster Session:

- UMMC Department of Medicine faculty (primary and cross appointed), collaborators, fellows, residents, medical students, and research staff are invited to submit abstracts of their ongoing research and clinical scholarship to the General Poster Session at the online submission form
- Abstracts presented at professional meetings during the past twenty-four months are also eligible for consideration.
- Submission of more than one abstract is allowed provided that each poster is presented by a different person in the list of authors (i.e. one person can only present one poster).
- Faculty and staff posters are not eligible for prize judging, and should be entered into the General Session.

Trainee Poster Competition:

- UMMC trainees in the Department of Medicine (students, residents, fellows, and other trainees), or trainees who have rotated through the department in the last 24 months are invited to submit abstracts to the Trainee Poster Competition. Trainees are defined as those currently enrolled in a formal course of study or training program at UMMC during the period of research.
- Research subject matter must be specifically related to one of the clinical divisions within the Department of Medicine: Allergy/Immunology, Cardiology, Digestive Diseases, Endocrinology, General Internal Medicine/Hypertension, Geriatrics, Hematology/Oncology, Hospitalist Medicine, JHS, Infectious Diseases, Nephrology, Pulmonary/Critical Care/Sleep Medicine, or Rheumatology/Molecular Immunology.
- Trainee must be mentored by a Department of Medicine Faculty member.
- Poster must be presented by the trainee, who must also be the first author in order to be eligible to compete for awards.
- Presenter must be available to discuss poster with the judges from 9:30 a.m. - 11:00 a.m., no exceptions (please make arrangements for this in advance).
- MSRP presenters will enter the trainee poster competition, but will be judged by a separate MSRP judging panel.
